most distinctive feature of Jesus' teaching methods

 - 2. The **Characteristics** - mainly to illustrate

 - H. **NT Use of OT**
 - 1. The **Extent** - 10% of NT
 - 2. The **Sources** - rarely verbatim quotes
 - 3. The **Interpretation** - discern purpose of quotation
 - I. **Other Genres**
 - 1. **Legal Literature** - mainly Mosaic Law
 - 2. **Allegories**
