WILLFUL SIN

1. **ΕΚΟΥΣΙΩΣ** - deliberate, intentional, obstinate
2. **OT** - swift punishment
Ex 22:19-20, Lev 20:9-19, 24:11-17
3. **Unintentional sin** - sacrifice
Num 15:27, 29 but 15:30-31

NO SACRIFICE

- **Our eternal position -

- **Our temporal relationship -
10:26-30**
- **Sacrifice can no longer
protect from discipline**
