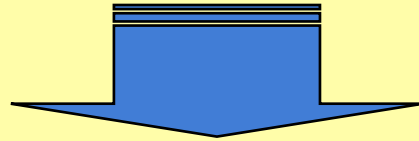

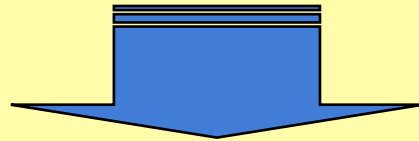

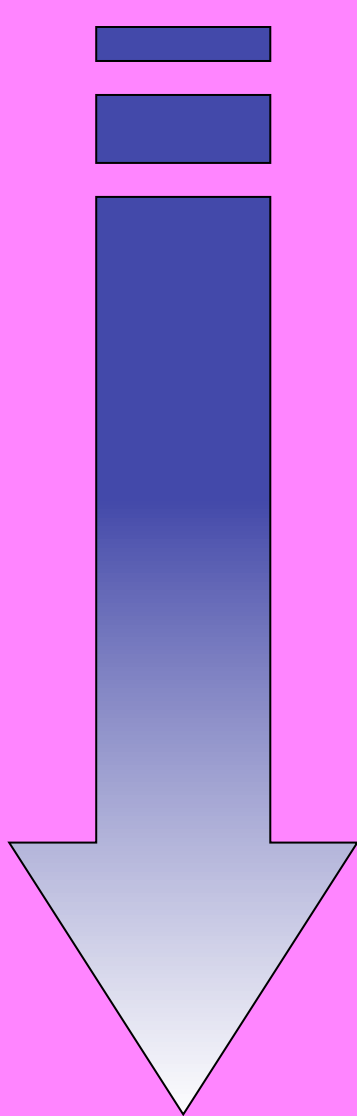

- **Term - παραδιδομι (paradidomi)**
- **Usage - 119x**
  - betray Jesus - Judas (31%)**
  - hand over for cross (19%)**
  - deliver believers (18%)**
  - to give up, abandon (4x)**

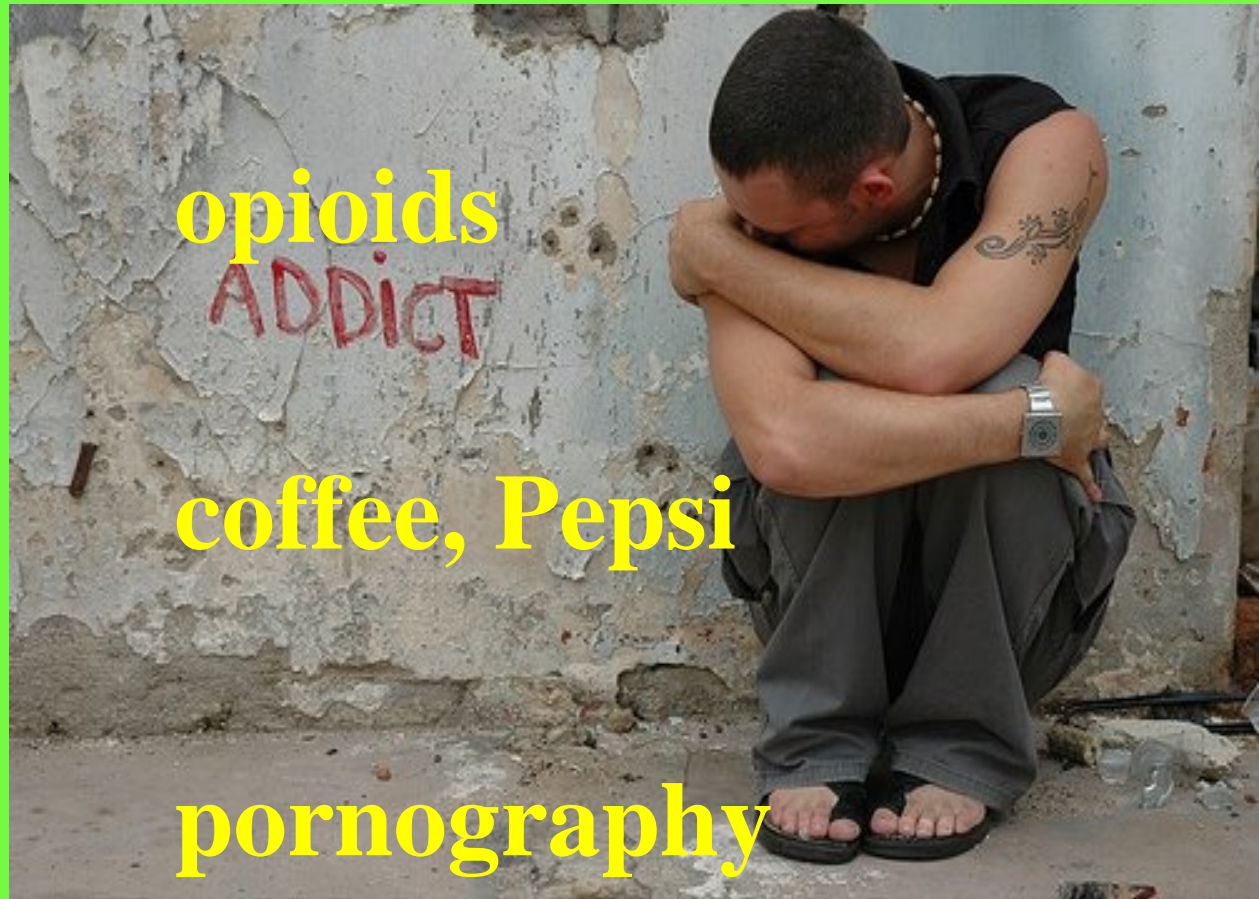
