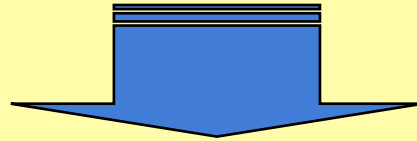

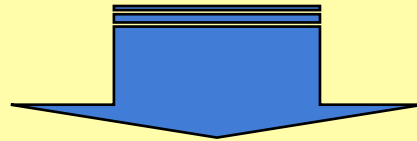

1. κρινω (krino) - verb, to judge
2. κατακρινω (katakriino) - verb,  
to condemn
3. κριμα (krima) - noun,  
judgment

1. Divine judgment
2. Man under condemnation

3. HS - "Spirit of truth"
4. His Word - "... word is truth"
5. Gospel - "... truth of the gospel"
6. Not man "... suppress the truth"
