



SALVATION (σωζω)

1. Physical harm - Act 27:20, 31
2. Eternal Hell - Eph 2:5, 8
3. Future completion - 1Pet 1:5
4. Present experience - Phil 2:12,
1Cor 1:18, Jas 1:21

SALVATION

- **Past = JUSTIFICATION**
from **PENALTY** of Sin
- **Future = GLORIFICATION**
from **PRESENCE** of Sin
- **Present = SANCTIFICATION**
from **POWER** of Sin

KEY IDEAS
