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KEY IDEAS

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SALVATION

- **Past = JUSTIFICATION**
from **PENALTY** of Sin
- **Future = GLORIFICATION**
from **PRESENCE** of Sin
- **Present = SANCTIFICATION**
from **POWER** of Sin

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RECONCILIATION

2Cor 5:17-18 Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come. 18 Now all these things are from God, who reconciled (καταλλάσσω) us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation (καταλλαγή),

RECONCILIATION

Col 1:21-22 And although you were formerly: alienated and hostile in mind, engaged in evil deeds, 22 yet He has **now reconciled** (αποκαταλλαττω) **you** in His fleshly body through death, in order to present you before Him holy and blameless and beyond reproach—

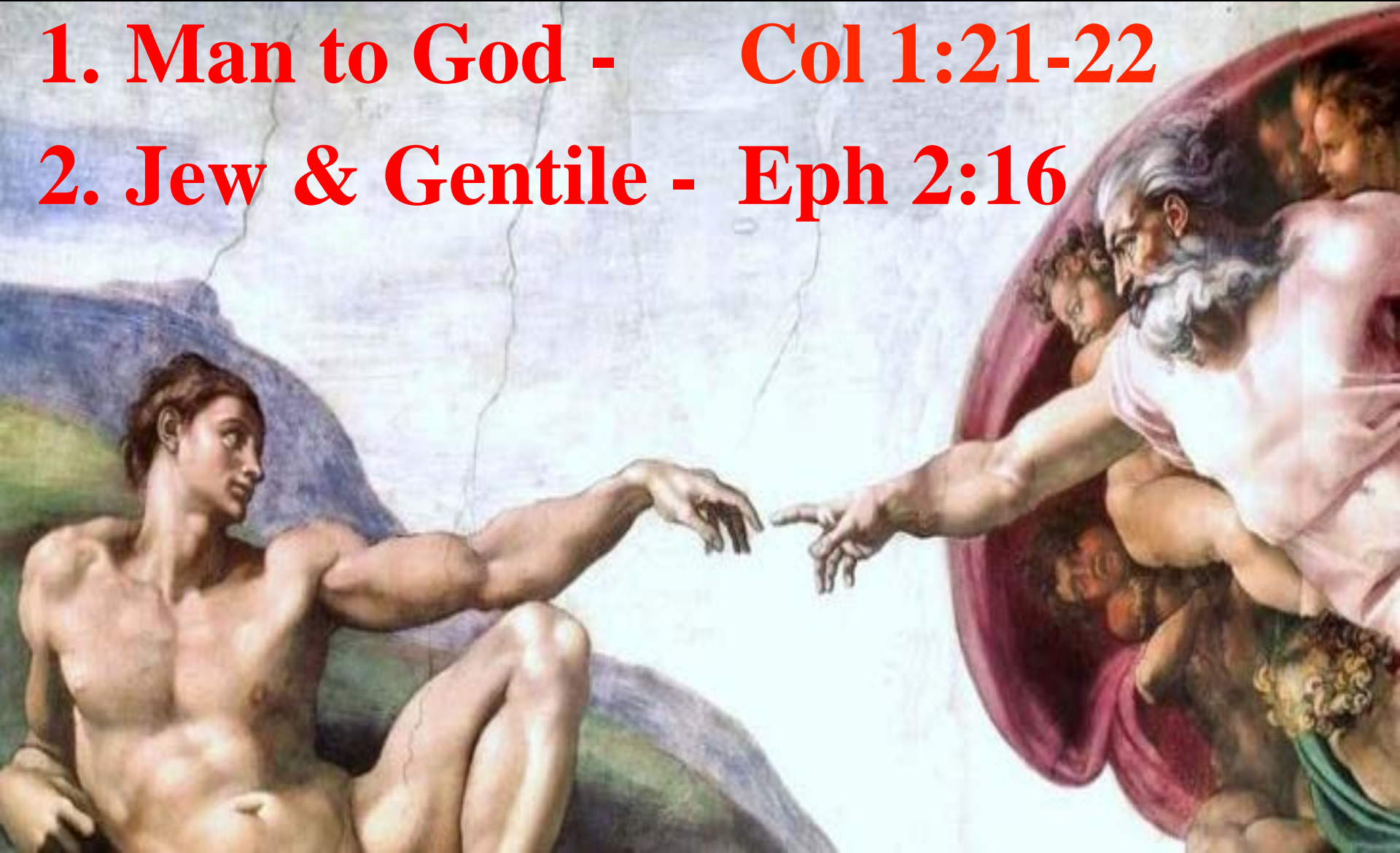

RECONCILIATION

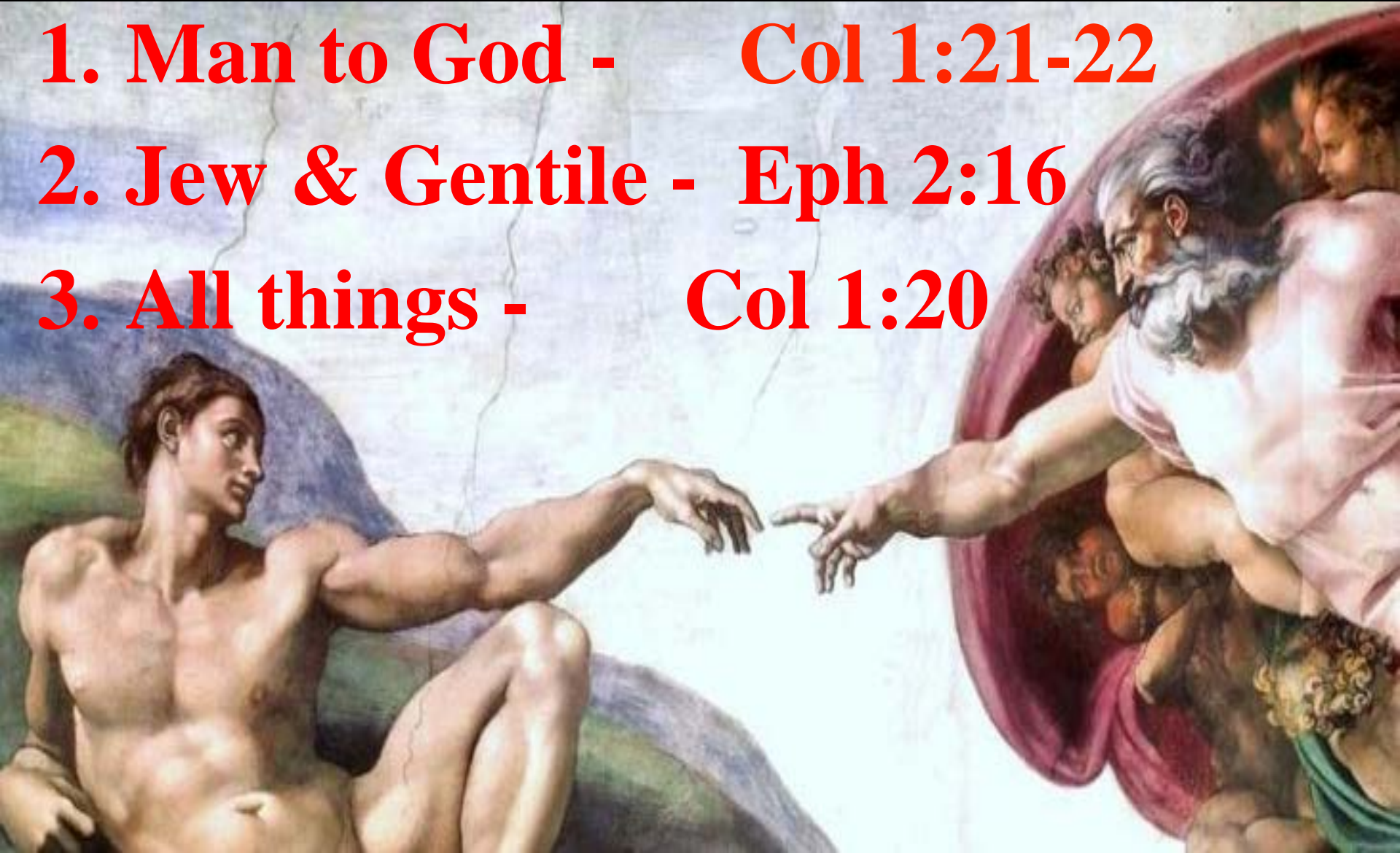
Col 1:20 and through Him to reconcile (αποκαταλλατω) all things to Himself, having made peace through the blood of His cross; through Him, I say, whether things on earth or things in heaven.

RECONCILIATION

2Cor 5:18-19 ... and gave us the ministry of reconciliation (καταλλαγη), 19 namely, that God was in Christ reconciling (καταλασσω) the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and He has committed to us the word of reconciliation (καταλλαγη).

RECONCILIATION

2Cor 5:20 Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were making an appeal through us; we beg you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled (καταλασσω) to God.

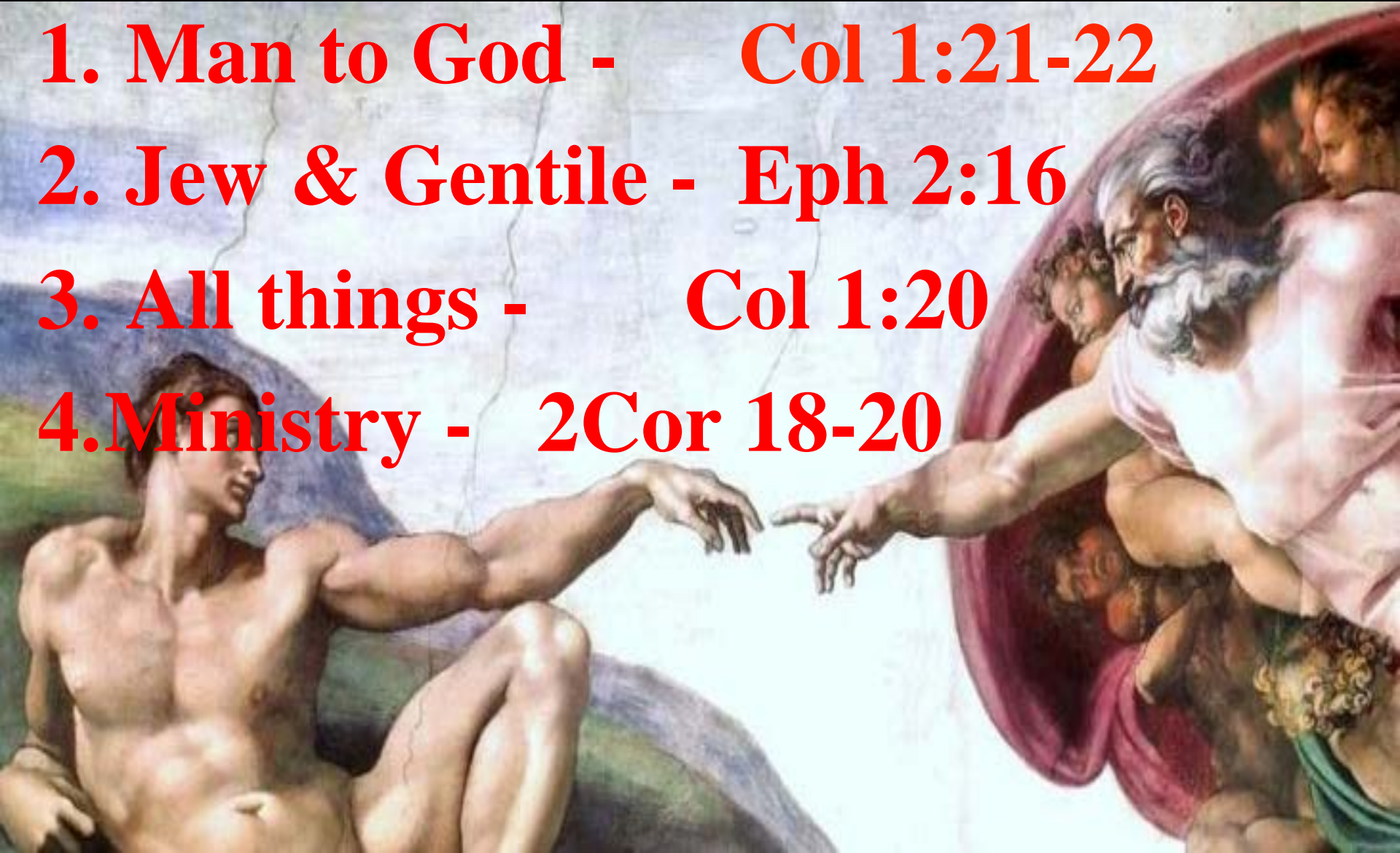

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GOD'S WORK

- **Helpless** - **Died** -> **regeneration**
- **Ungodly** - **Justified** -> **righteousness**
- **Sinner** - **Saved** -> **forgiveness**
- **Enemies** - **Reconciled** -> **friendship**

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PRESENT SALVATION

5:9 - by His blood = death

Basis for all aspects of salvation

Penalty of sin paid - no wrath

5:10 - by His life

**Christian life powered by
resurrection life**

- 6. Exultation - boasting, exuberant rejoicing for His grace**

5:11 And not only this, but we also exult in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation (καταλλαγη).
