





1:1-17

- a. Reign of Death thru One 5:12-17
 - 1) Devastating Reign of Death 5:12a) Entrance of Sin & Death

5:12 Therefore, just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men, because all sinned --

5:18 So then as through one transgression there resulted condemnation to all men, even so through one act of righteousness there resulted justification of life to all men.

5:14 Nevertheless death reigned from Adam until Moses, even over those who had not sinned in the likeness of the offense of Adam, who is a type of Him who was to come.



5:15-16 But the free gift (xapioµa) is not like the transgression. For if by the transgression of the one the many died, much more did the grace ($\chi \alpha \rho \iota s$) of God and the gift ($\delta \omega \rho \epsilon \alpha$) by the grace (xapis) of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abound to the many. 16 The gift $(\delta \omega \rho \eta \mu \alpha)$ is not like that which came through the one who sinned; for on the one hand the judgment arose from one transgression resulting in condemnation, but on the other hand the free gift ($\chi \alpha \rho \iota \sigma \mu \alpha$) arose from many transgressions resulting in justification.

5:17 For if by the transgression of the one, death reigned through the one, much more those who receive the abundance of grace (xaples) and of the gift ($\delta \omega \rho \in \alpha$) of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.

JUDGMENT

 \succ κριμα (krima) - sentence of judge, judgment > κατακριμα (katakrima) execution of sentence, servitude to sin
