Church of Holy Sepulcher Job 11:7 "Can you discover the depths of God? Can you discover the limits of the Almighty? 8 "They are high as the heavens, what can you do? **Deeper** than Sheol, what can you know? 9 "Its measure is longer than the earth And broader than the sea.

Ps 139:6 Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; It is too high, I cannot attain to it. Isa 55:8-9 "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, Nor are your ways My ways," declares the Lord. 9 "For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways And My thoughts than your thoughts.

ANTI-THEISTIC

Anti-theistic Biblical Departures



Deism - god is transcendent but not immanent impersonal, infinite, holy but not sovereign **Dualism - 2 eternal & opposing** principles >Mysticism - over emphasis on immanence
