





WHITE STAR

- Diam = 865,000 mi 109x earth
- >From earth = 93 million mi
- \triangleright Earth's power = 1.73x10¹⁷ watts

- **►Light takes 8:20 min**
- >Orbits galaxy = 240 million yrs
