

- Occurrence - 10 of 33 times in Gen 1 (1:11-12, 21, 24-25)
- Meaning - Limitations of Variation
- Permanence - boundaries
- Self-reproducing - nothing man has made can reproduce itself

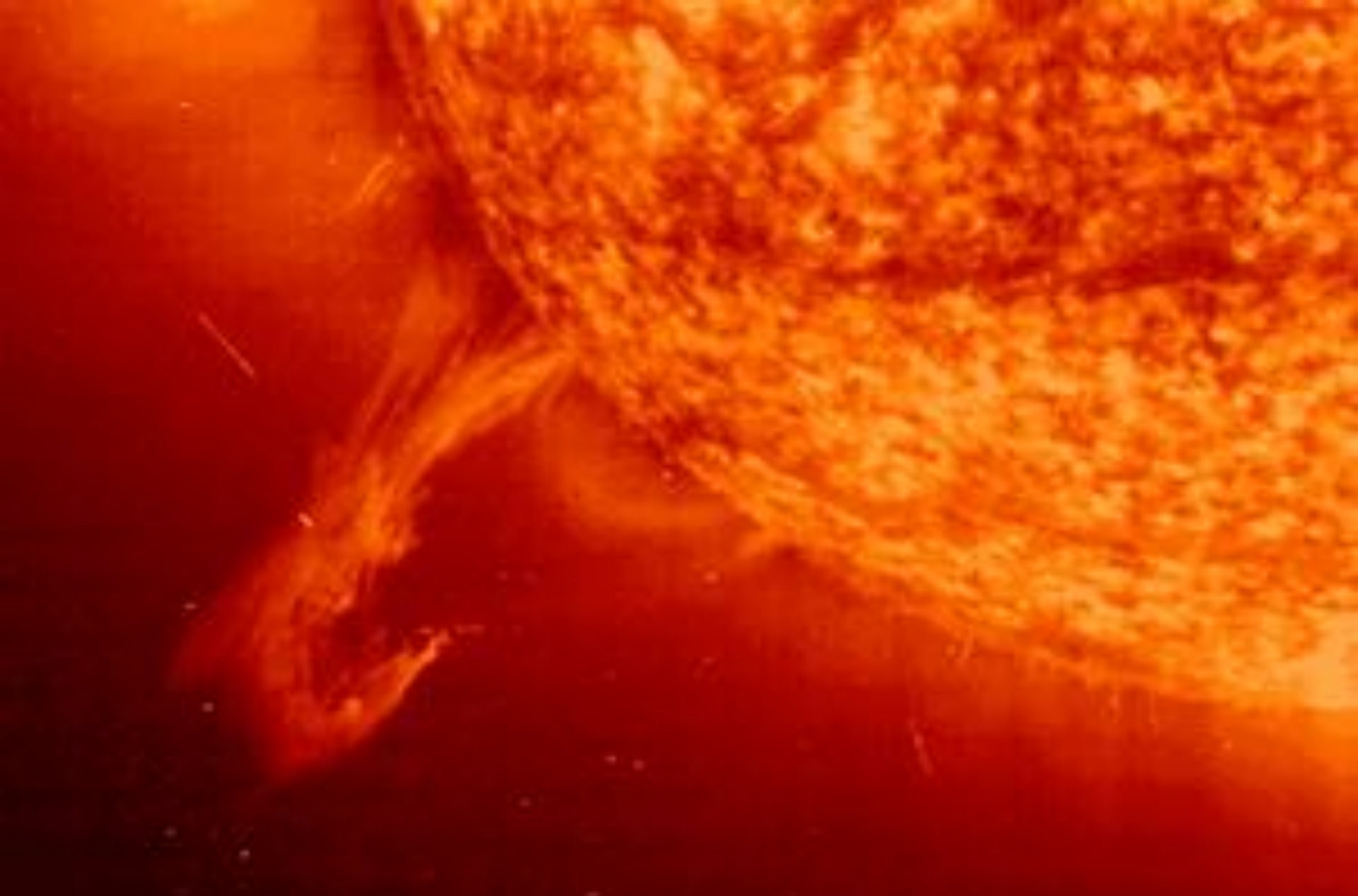

# WHITE STAR

- **Diam = 865,000 mi**  
**109x earth**
- **From earth = 93 million mi**
- **Earth's power =  $1.73 \times 10^{17}$  watts**
- **Light takes 8:20 min**
- **Orbits galaxy = 240 million yrs**



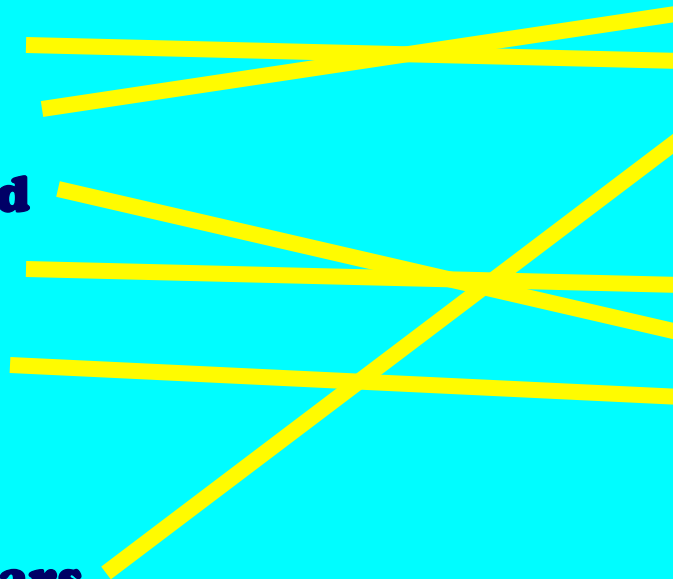
