




DESTRUCTION

- 605 Babylonian exile begins
 Daniel exiled with others
- 2. 602 Jehoiakim revolted

 Judah over run by enemies
- 3. 597 Nebuchadnezzar pillaged temple Ezekiel & others exiled
- 4. 586 Nebuchadnezzar destroys city
 70 year exile to 535






DURING EXILE



- 2. To show God as faithful to His covenant people in protection & preserving
- 3. To show Daniel as an example of godliness to exiles
