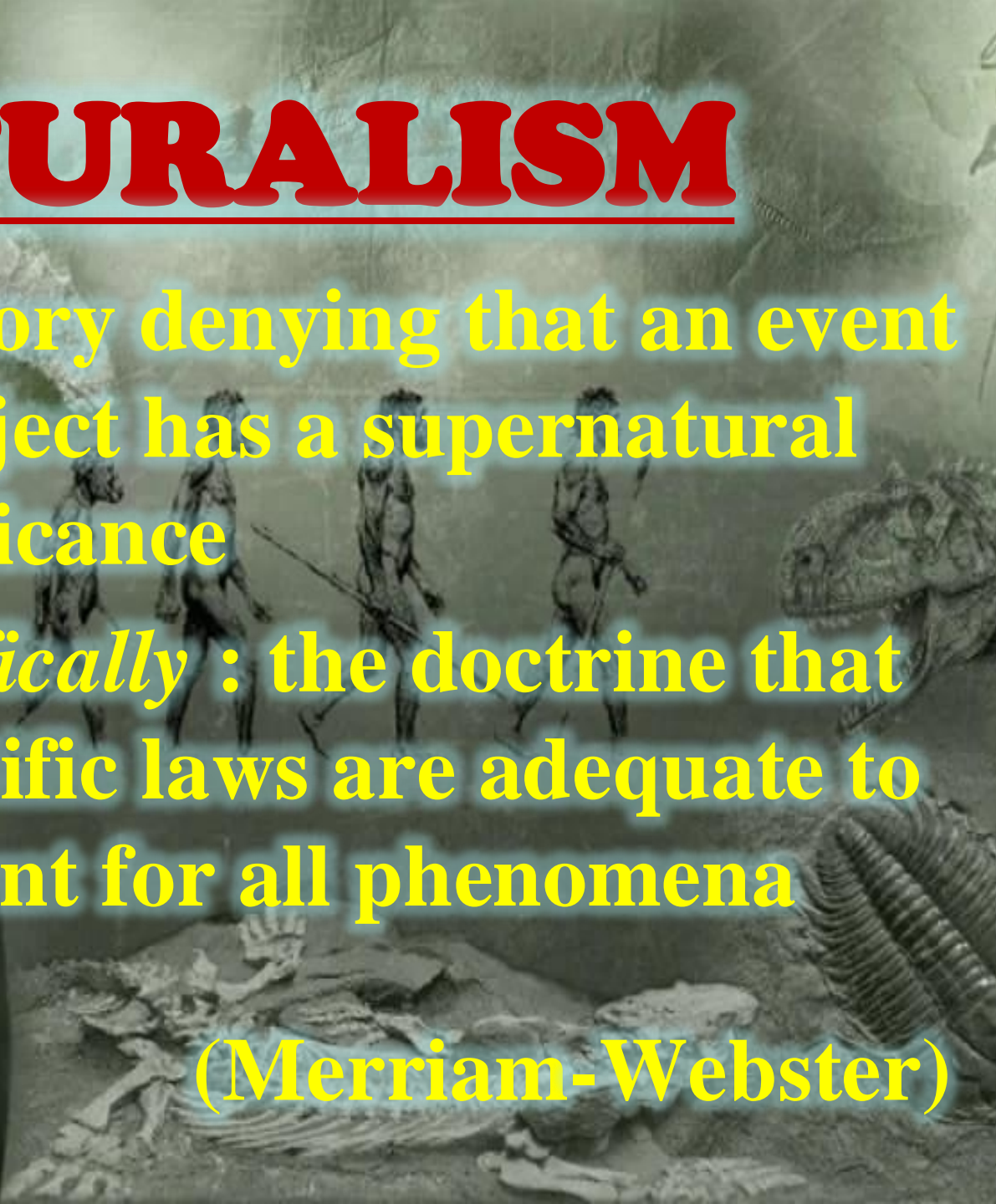
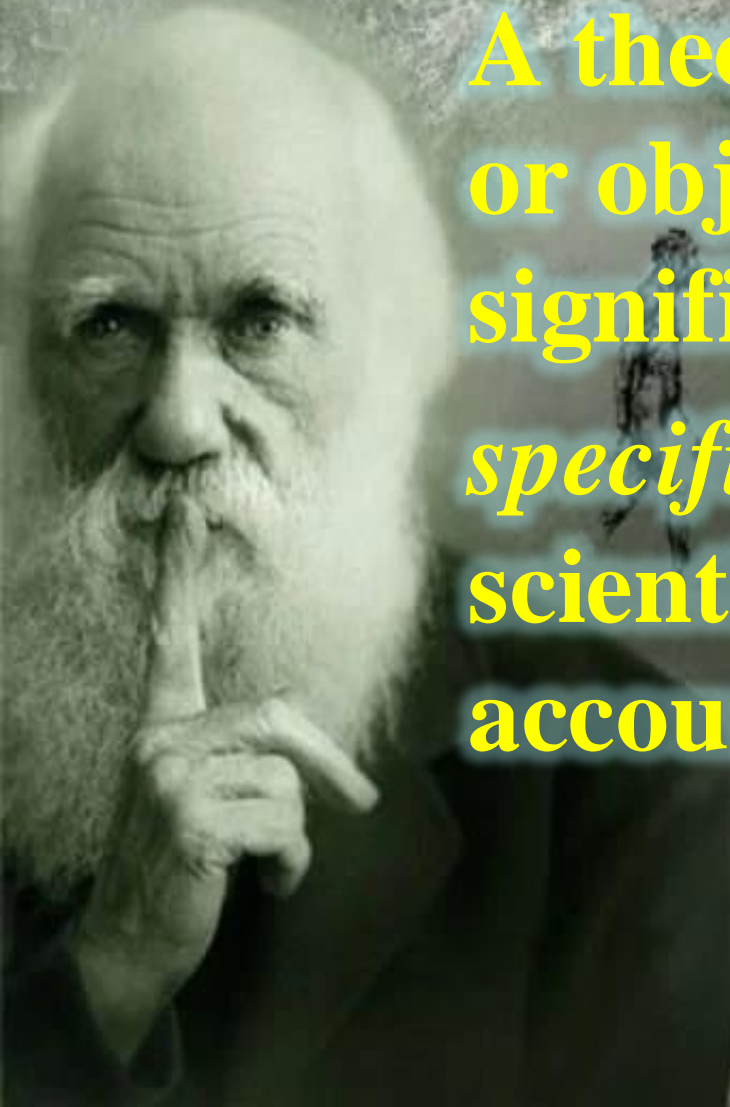
CREATION science
