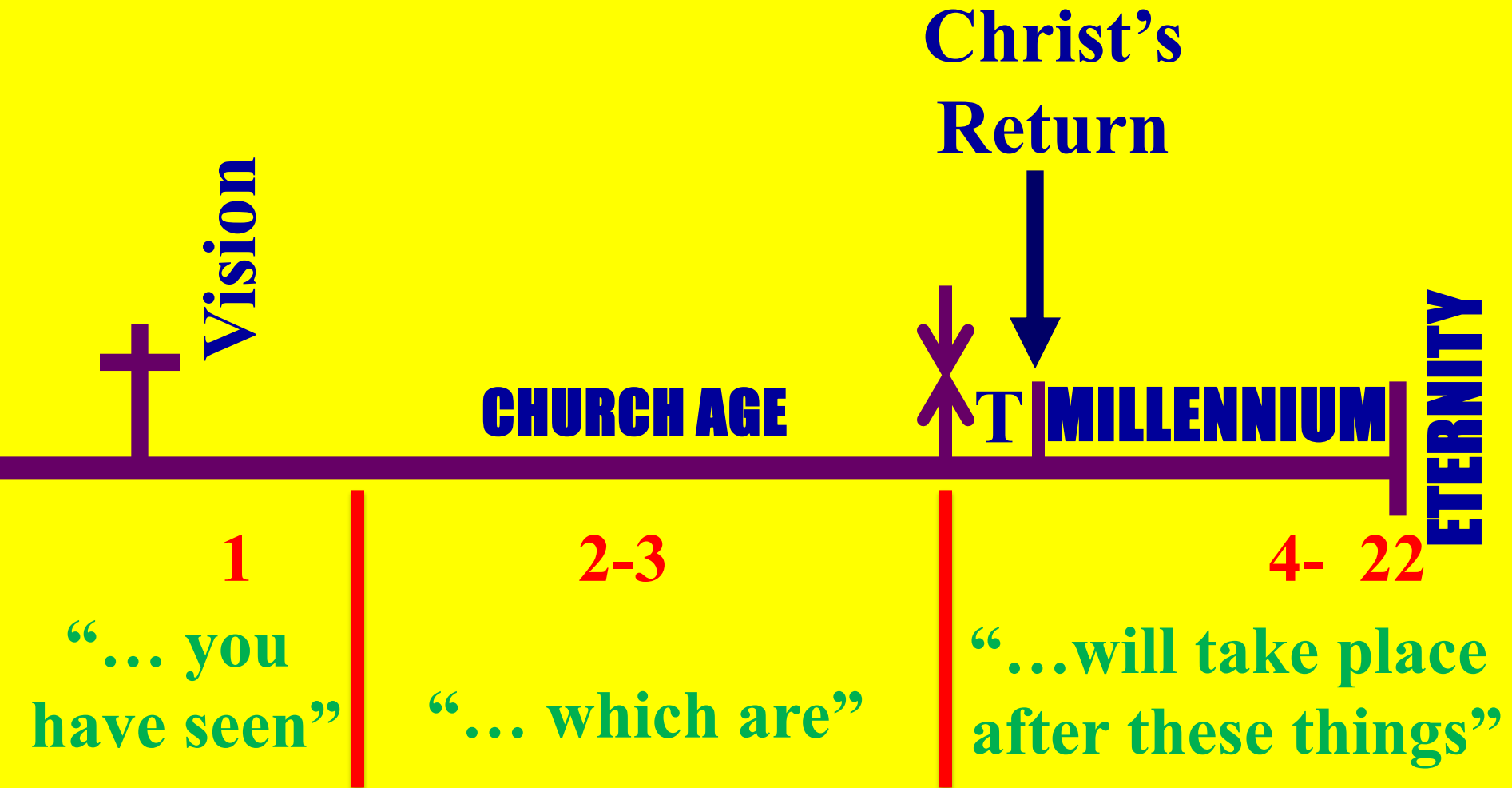

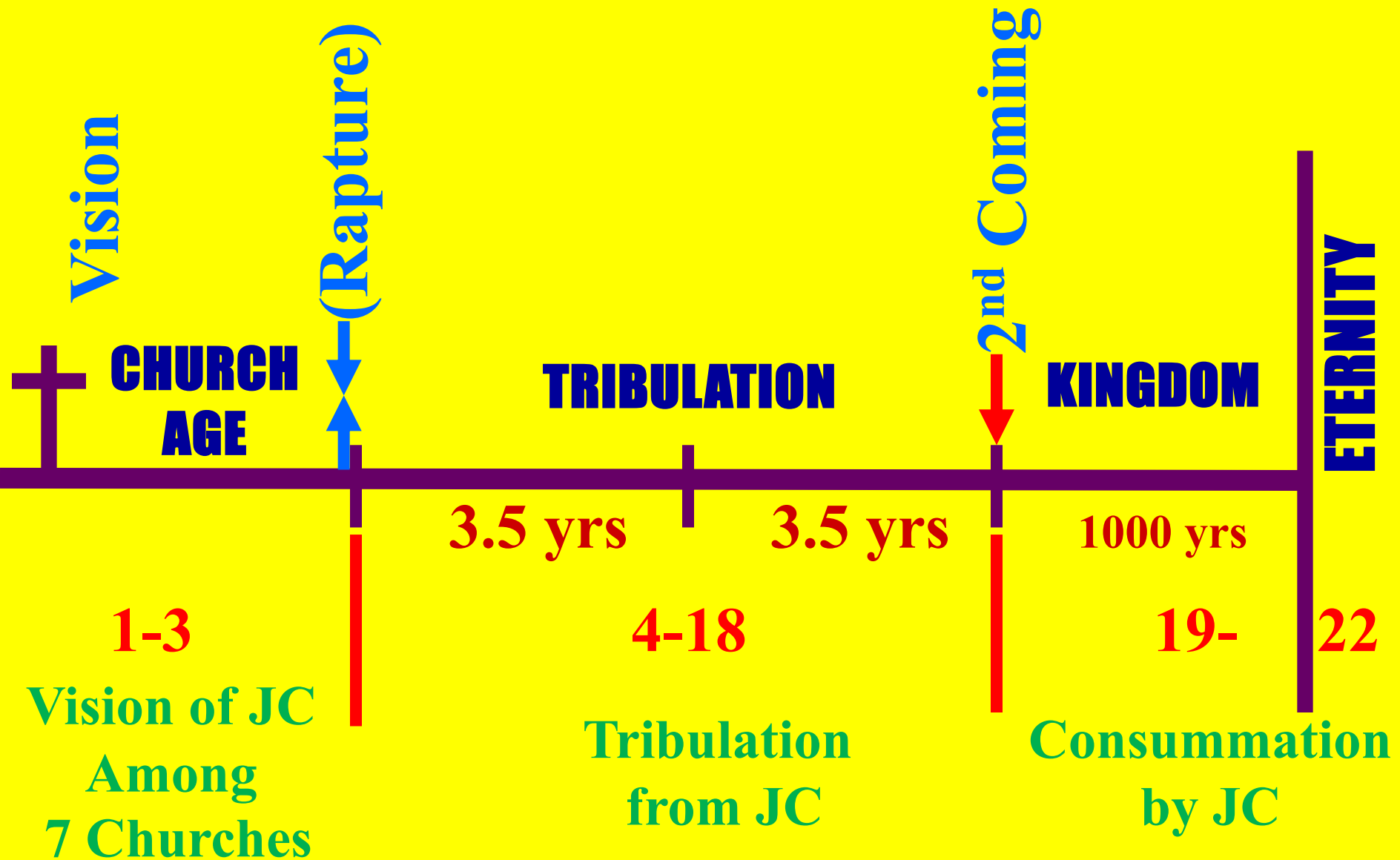

4:1-2 After these things I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven, and the first voice which I had heard, like the sound of a trumpet speaking with me, said, “Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after these things.” 2 Immediately I was in the Spirit; and behold, a throne was standing in heaven, and One sitting on the throne.

**5:1 I saw in the right hand of Him
who sat on the throne a book
written inside and on the back,
sealed up with seven seals.**

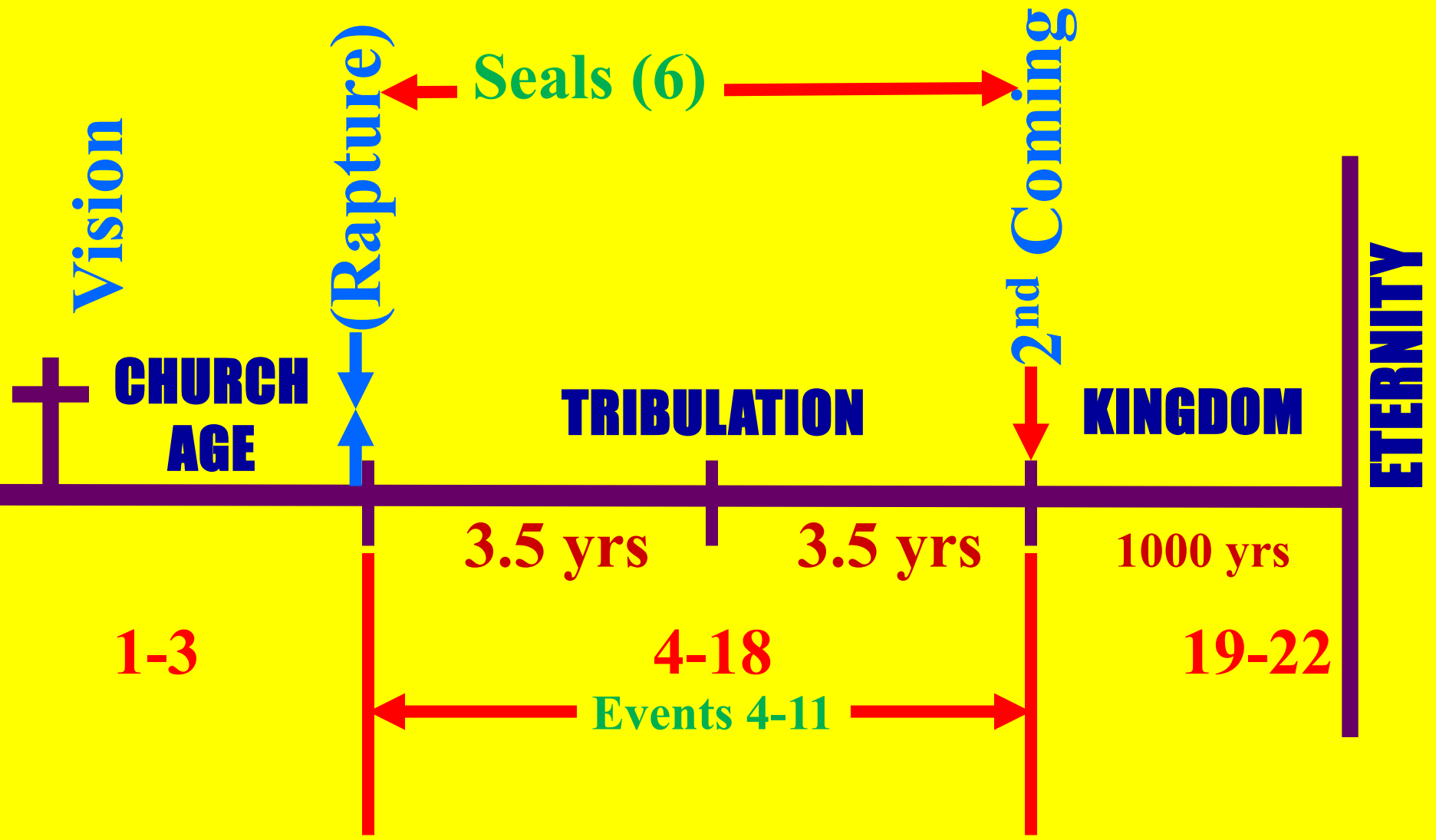

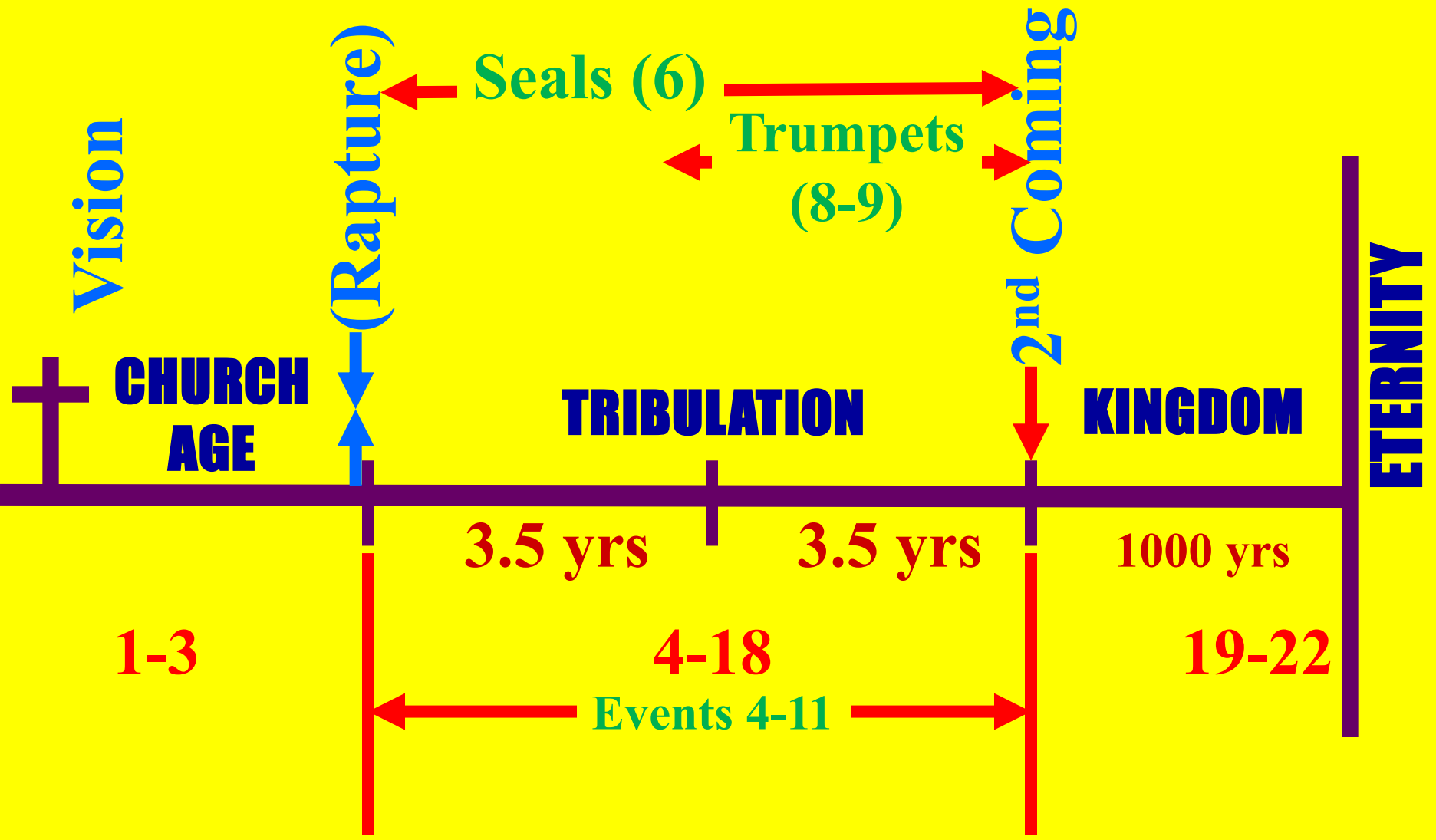

9:1-3 Then the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star from heaven which had fallen to the earth; and the key of the bottomless pit was given to him. 2 He opened the bottomless pit, ... 3 Then out of the smoke came locusts upon the earth, and power was given them, as the scorpions of the earth have power.

9:4-5 They were told not to hurt the grass of the earth, ... , but only the men who do not have the seal of God on their foreheads. 5 And they were not permitted to kill anyone, but to torment for five months; and their torment was like the torment of a scorpion when it stings a man.
