

 αδυνατος - powerless, impossible
 ανακαινιζω - renew, restore only here, noun only 2x



> Does not = eternal life, salvation Salvation is by faith alone >Means more than "change of mind" >Includes changing direction, getting back to God, including remorse **Can refer to believer repenting**
