**6:4 For in the case of those who ...,
6 and then have fallen away, it is
impossible to renew them again to
repentance, since they again crucify
to themselves the Son of God and
put Him to open shame.**

IMPOSSIBILITY

1. No conditional element
2. Not related to salvation
3. Renew to fellowship
4. Repentance from apostasy
5. Point of no return possibility

μετάνοια

- **Does not = eternal life or salvation**
- **Salvation is by faith alone**
- **Means more than “change of mind”**
- **Includes changing direction, getting back to God, including remorse**
- **Can refer to believer repenting**

- ανα** - **again or back**
- σταυρω** - **to crucify**

SIGNIFICANCE

- **Present tense ptcp**
- **Specifies limits of Impossibility**
- **Jewish return to sacrifices to atone
for failure**
