2. Cain - יָדַע to fashion, shape, give form

2. Cain - to fashion, shape, give form
3. Gotten - word play with name Cain
קָיַן (qain) - קָנִיתִי (qaniti)
4. Man-child - אִישׁ (ish) = man
5. Literal - “I have gotten a man, YHWH”

4:2 Again, she gave birth to his brother Abel. And Abel was a keeper of flocks, but Cain was a tiller of the ground.

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

- Shepherd**

4:4-5 Abel, on his part also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of their fat portions. And the LORD had regard for Abel and for his offering; 5 but for Cain and for his offering He had no regard. So Cain became very angry and his countenance fell.

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4:8 Cain told Abel his brother.


And it came about when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother and killed him.
